CONTEST DATE & LOCATION: Refer to the Kansas State Championship Conference Packet

PURPOSE: To evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the field of residential and commercial carpentry.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to active SkillsUSA members enrolled in programs with carpentry as the occupational objective

CLOTHING REQUIREMENT: Unless the contest chair says otherwise, students are required to wear the Official SkillsUSA Kansas T-shirt and blue jeans (no tears, holes, or bagginess) clean and neat with appropriate shoes for contest or Official SkillsUSA Carhartt attire.

* Safety glasses with side shields or goggles. (Prescription glasses can be used only if they are equipped with side shields. If not, they must be covered with goggles.)

SAFETY GLASSES (clear ANSI approved)

(1) Claw Hammer

3/4 Inch Wood Chisel

Framing Square

16' or longer retractable tape measure

Utility knife with standard blades

Two pencils

Calculator

Large Black Marker (i.e. Sharpie Magnum)

One each - (#2 Phillips) & (8" Standard) screw drivers

Straight aviation snip or any metal-cutting snips

Cat's paw nail puller

Chalk box & line

One each- (1/32", 2/32"& 3/32") nail sets

24" or 30" spirit level

Carpenters tool and nail pouch with belt &/or suspenders

Stair gauges (optional)

Combination square and/or speed square

(1) 8pt. Crosscut saw (10 or 12pt. Optional)

Drywall/Sheet Rock Saw (Keyhole Saw)

Gloves appropriate for working with steel studs

14.4V (or higher) Cordless Drill or Cordless Drill/Driver

Coping Saw

Drill Bit Set for Cordless Drill to Include a minimum of: one apex (bit holder), #1, #2, #3 and drywall Phillips bits, #2 square drive bit, T15, T20 and T25 Torx bits, 1/16" through 1/2" drill bits, 5/8" and 3/4" paddle bits, Equipment carried in a carpenter's toolbox, tool bucket or other appropriate container
