**GENERAL INFORMATION**

To assist students who are pursuing career technical goals, SkillsUSA Kansas will award a maximum of six (6) scholarships per year. Each scholarship is a one-time award: Two (2) Bronze Level Award of \$300.00; Two (2) Silver Level Awards of \$500; and Two (2) Gold Level Awards of \$750. Scholarships are for high school junior or senior members and postsecondary members.

- Each scholarship is only awarded to active paid members of SkillsUSA Kansas. These scholarships may be used for tuition, books, or tools of the trade.
- The Scholarship Committee will award the scholarships into categories of Bronze, Silver, or Gold level scoring applicants in high school or college/postsecondary. The winners of the SkillsUSA Kansas Scholarships will be announced at the Opening Session of the annual **SkillsUSA Kansas Championships**.
