- ✓ A United States citizen or noncitizen who has a current lawful presence in the United States and a work permit.

Applicants should:

- ✓ Have a GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- ✓ Be enrolled in a demanding course of study

Applicants would:

- ✓ Demonstrate a desire to work in the field of Diesel Technology
- ✓ Demonstrate a desire to make a meaningful contribution to society both present and future.
- ✓ Be involved in a balance of community, school and work activities
- ✓ Pursue goals and aspirations with integrity, resolution, self-discipline and judgement
- Demonstrate leadership characteristics and/or assumed leadership positions
