Qualifications:

Gold Medalist must be:

- ✓ Pursuing a certificate or an associate's degree at a "Kansas" Community/Technical College.
- ✓ A United States citizen or noncitizen who has a current lawful presence in the United States and a work permit.
- ✓ Awarded 1st place/Gold Medallion in the Diesel Equipment Technology Kansas State Championship Competition.
- ✓ Planning to attend the National Leadership and Skills Championship Conference.

Gold medalist will be recognized on Stage at the Kansas State Championships by the Tyler Loomis Family during the Closing Ceremony. NOTE: It is required those receiving awards be dressed in professional attire or national standard contest attire in order to receive any awards on stage.
