## **Qualifications:**

Gold Medalist must be:

- ✓ An entering or returning student at an accredited institution in Kansas and must be enrolled in a Automotive Technology Program.
- ✓ Pursuing a career in Automotive Service Technology
- ✓ A United States citizen or noncitizen who has a current lawful presence in the United States and a work permit.
- ✓ Awarded 1<sup>st</sup> place/Gold Medallion in the Automotive Service Technology Kansas State Championship Competition.
- ✓ Planning to attend the National Leadership and Skills Championship Conference.

Gold medalist will be recognized on Stage at the Kansas State Championships by a representative of the Kansas Board of Directors and/or Snap-on Tools Representative during the Closing Ceremony. NOTE: It is required those receiving awards be dressed in professional attire or national standard contest attire in order to receive any awards on stage.
